

Strong strike mandate from three CUPE locals, votes continue for other locals

Yesterday, CUPE Locals **1840** (Court Stenographers), **1866** (WorkSafeNB) and **5017** (New Brunswick Community Colleges) counted their strike vote ballots. Here are the results:

- CUPE Local 1840: 96% turn out, 96% yes
- CUPE Local 1866: 88% turn out, 83% yes
- CUPE Local 5017: 97% turn out, 90% yes

CUPE Locals **1190** (General Labour & Trades), **1418** (Rehab & Therapy), **1251** (Institutional Services), **1253** (School districts unions) and **2745** (school support staff) will resume their strike votes on Friday and Saturday, September 17 and 18, for those members left off lists or who have not voted yet.

CUPE Locals **1252** (Healthcare) and **5026** (Collèges communautaires du N.-B.) will vote before the end of September.

Additional strong strike mandates will help your centralized bargaining team push for better wages for all.
