The 10 bargaining teams who make up the Centralized Bargaining Team met this Tuesday and Wednesday to finalize details on imminent job action.

The bargaining teams worked out the strike plan, identified collective strike headquarters and picket line sites throughout the province, and more.

On October 19th Premier Higgs responded to our October 7th letter. In his response, it's clear Higgs maintains his demands for concessions, and is not prepared to offer real wage improvements for all CUPE members in bargaining.
