

Collèges communautaires du N.-B. workers (Local 5026) vote for strike action, Local 1190 starts voting today

Today, CUPE Local 5026 (CCNB) counted their strike vote ballots. Here are the results:

- **CUPE Local 5026:** 84 members voted, 96% voted yes

There is only one CUPE local part of the centralized bargaining team that has yet to complete its strike vote. **CUPE Local 1190** (General Labour & Trades) has started their strike votes today, October 1, and will continue on October 2 and 4. Vote count will be held October 5.

Your centralized bargaining team sent a letter back to Premier Higgs, following his correspondence of September 27th. You can consult that letter on the CUPE NB website. In it, we re-affirm we look forward to going back to the table, but that we will only do so once he removes the concessions. It's in the Premier's hands to ensure there are no disruptions to our public services.
